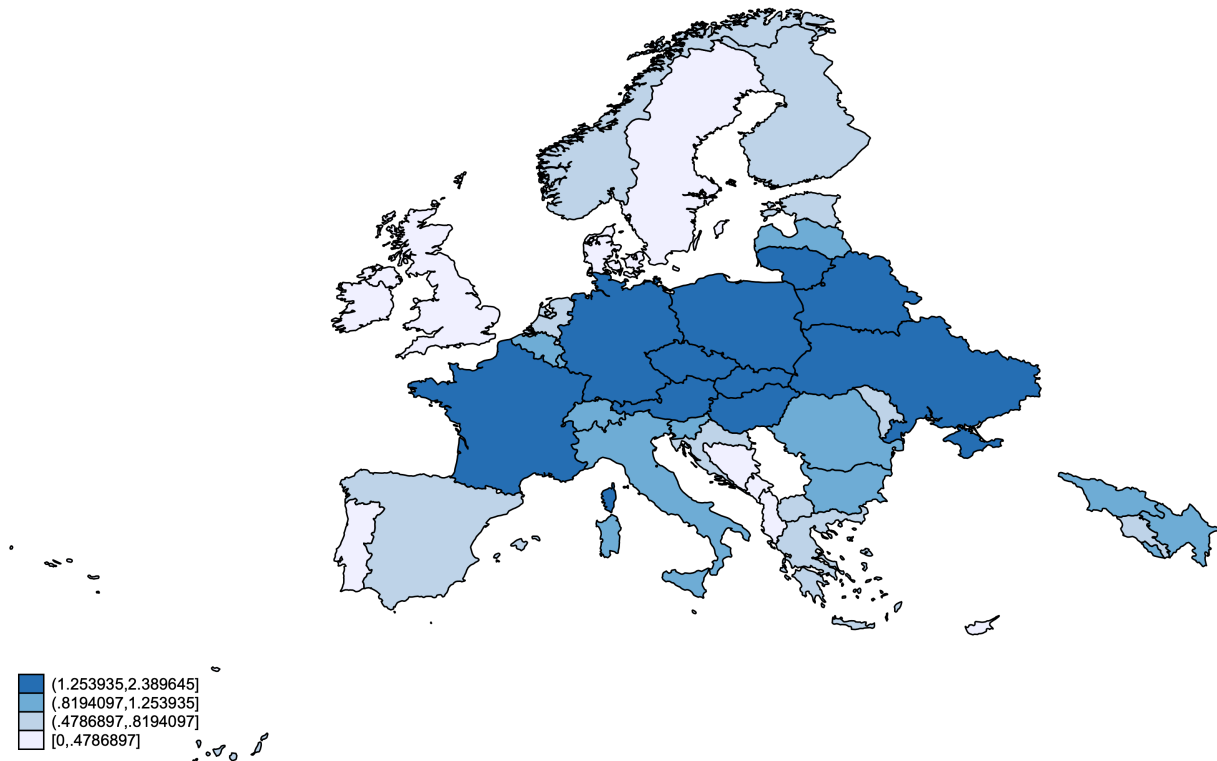


New publication on spatial-x models
